Jean-Luc AEGERTER, Grand Cru 2008 Clos de Vougeot :

Aegerter's Clos Vougeot has an odd nose, one that I thought was corked at first, but was just a little « mulchy » and « compost-like » with some vegetal aromas in the background. The palate is medium-bodied with firm tannins, very natural almost to the point of being laid back, but I appreciate the refined strawberry and raspberry leaf fruit profile and the finish is well defined and focused. After 5 minutes, the nose has dispensed with some of its rusticity and greenness, although it does not quite have the delineation that the palate deserves.



Jean-Luc AEGERTER, Grand Cru 2008 Clos de Vougeot :

Mid ruby. Already some bouquet – quite autumnal. A certainly delicate charm on the palate, though still with 2008's high acidity. Well defined and with impressive length.
